Dear Parents/Guardians:

The administration of student medications, either prescription or non-prescription, during school hours is strongly discouraged as there are safety concerns about students forgetting to take the medication, having a reaction to the medication, or other students taking the medication.

If a physician deems it medically necessary for a student to take medications during the school day, either prescription or non-prescription, the Authorization for Medication and Release of Medical Information Form must be completed and returned to the health office. The form must be signed by the parent, completed by the physician, and submitted with the medication in its original or pharmacy labeled container. A new form is required for each medication, dose, or time change and for each school year. It is the responsibility of the student to report to the health office for his/her medication.

Failure to comply with these procedures may result in your child not receiving his/her medication.

Feel free to contact the school nurse if you have any concerns regarding this matter.
