

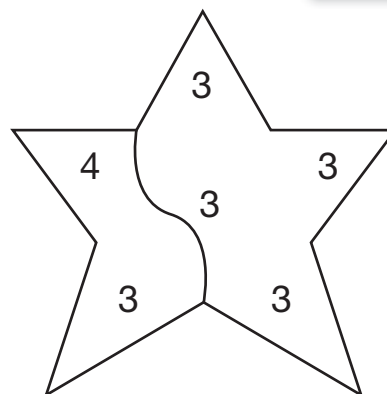

Separate the Shapes

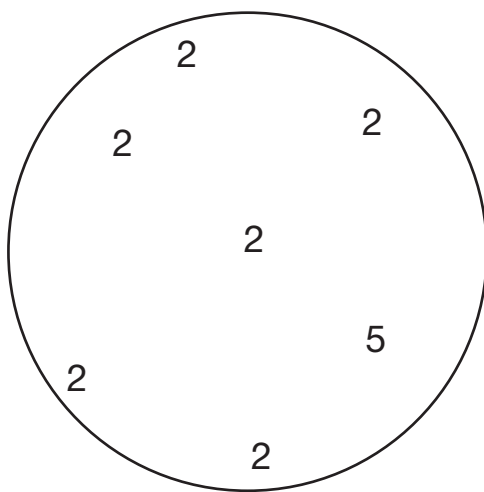
Draw one line to separate the numbers.

$$4 \times 3 = 12$$

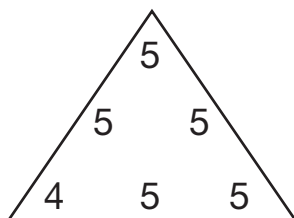
