Cami has 12 crayons and some cans.

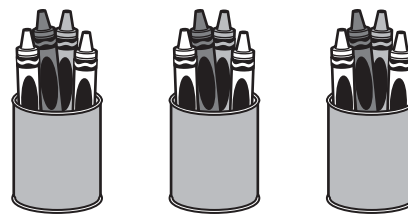
She puts 4 crayons into each can.
