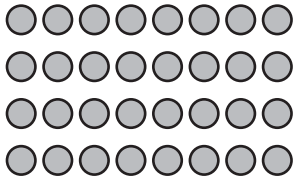


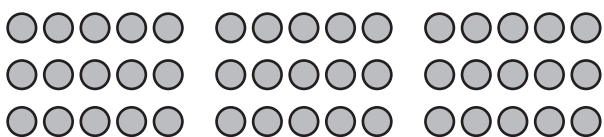
Fact Families with 8 and 9

Multiplication facts can help you to find division facts when 8 or 9 is the divisor.

There are 32 counters. There are 8 counters in each row. How many rows are there?



There are 45 counters. There are 9 rows. How many counters are in each row?



What You Think	What You Write	What You Think	What You Write
8 times what number equals 32? $8 \times 4 = 32$	$32 \div 8 = 4$ There are 4 rows of counters.	9 times what number equals 45? $9 \times 5 = 45$	$45 \div 9 = 5$ There are 5 counters in each row.
