## Multiplication and Division Facts

A class is making popcorn for a carnival. Each batch makes 30 cups. They put the popcorn in bags that hold 6 cups each.
How many bags of popcorn does one batch make?
You can solve the problem using division or multiplication.

## Division

How many groups of 6 are in 30 ?


Divide the total number of cups by the number of cups in each bag: $30 \div 6=\mathbf{5} \longleftarrow$ Number of bags

## Multiplication

What number times 6 equals 30 ?


Each batch of popcorn makes 5 bags.
