biodegradable material a material that can be broken down by biological processes

C

compost a mixture of decomposing organic matter, such as manure and rotting plants, that is used as fertilizer and soil conditioner

D

deep-well injection deep-well disposal of hazardous waste

Н

hazardous wastes wastes that are a risk to the health of humans or other living organisms

L

landfill an area of land or an excavation where wastes are placed for permanent disposal

leachate a liquid that has passed through solid waste and has extracted dissolved or suspended materials from that waste, such as pesticides in the soil

M

municipal solid waste waste produced by households and businesses

R

recycling the process of recovering valuable or useful materials from waste or scrap; the process of reusing some items

S

solid waste a discarded solid material, such as garbage, refuse, or sludges **source reduction** any change in the design, manufacture, purchase, or use of materials or products to reduce their amount or toxicity before they become municipal solid waste; also the reuse of products or materials

surface impoundment a natural depression or a human-made excavation that serves as a disposal facility that holds an accumulation of wastes
