

- 1. a region of evergreen, coniferous forest below the arctic and subarctic tundra regions
- 2. community dominated by grasses with few trees; characterized by cold winters and rainfall that is intermediate between that of a forest and a desert
- 3. a forest community (or biome), characterized by cool, humid weather and abundant rainfall, and the forest floor is covered with ferns
- 4. the top foliage layer in a forest where the trees extend above surrounding trees
- 5. a plant that uses another plant for support, but not for nourishment
- 6. a treeless plain that is located in the Arctic or Antarctic and that is characterized by very low winter temperatures
- 7. the distance north or south from the equator, expressed in degrees

- 8. the height of an object above a reference point, such as sea level or the Earth's surface
- 9. a type of vegetation that includes broad-leafed evergreen shrubs and that is located in areas with hot, dry summers and mild, wet winters
- 10. a forest or jungle near the equator that is characterized by large amounts of rain and little variation in temperature
- 11. the average weather conditions in an area over a long period of time
- 12. a forest (or biome) that is characterized by trees that shed their leaves in the fall
- 13. a foliage layer that is beneath and shaded by the main canopy of a forest
- 14. the layers of treetops that shade the forest floor
- 15. a large region characterized by a specific type of climate and certain types of plant and animal communities
- 16. a plain full of grasses ad scattered trees and shrubs
- 17. in arctic regions, the permanently frozen layer of soil or subsoil
- 18. a region that has little or no vegetation, long periods without rain, and extreme temperatures; usually found in warm climates
