You will be required to prepare an informational guide, which will not only inform the class on your biome, but will give them a "virtual tour". You will earn **14 points** for making the guide plus those points indicated below. You can make sure that the class has understood your presentation by giving them a worksheet or quiz on the information you are presenting.
