

- 1. classification system in which each species is assigned a two-part scientific name (2)
- 2. larger, more inclusive taxonomic category than a kingdom
- 4. trait that appears in recent parts of a lineage, but not in its older members (2)
- 7. group of closely related species; the first part of the scientific name in binomial nomenclature
- domain consisting of unicellular prokaryotes that have cell walls that do not contain peptidoglycan; corresponds to kingdom archaebacteria
- 10. diagram depicting patterns of shared characteristics among species
- 11. the evolutionary history of a lineage
- 13. domain of unicellular prokaryotes that have cell walls containing peptidoglycan; corresponds to the kingdom eubacteria
- 15. evolutionary branch of a cladogram that includes a single ancestor and all its descendants
- 16. in classification, a group of closely related classes
